- 5) PFA request for funding re shortfall (£2263) the emails from the PFA Chair were distributed to all the Cllrs. It was unanimously agreed by Cllrs to make a contribution of £600 from the Parish Council's Well Being allowance to help the PFA towards their application.
- **6) New Internet Bank** the account is now operational and the initial deposit of £500 has been credited. The transfer of funds (agenda point 4b) will enable the PC to trial the new way of banking for a few months. Letters from Unity Trust Bank have been sent to ClIrs as signatories for completion
